Subject: Notice of Water Rate Change

The Copeville Special Utility District buys all its water from the North Texas Municipal Water District. We were notified in September 2024 by North Texas Municipal Water District that the cost of water would increase beginning October 1, 2024. As a result of this increased cost the District performed a rate study to obtain correct information on what the water rates needed to be for the District to meet our financial obligations. As a result of the rate study please see below for the new water rates. If you are using 5,000 gallons per month, your bill will increase by \$2.40. All rates below do not include the Service Fee.

Our existing rates are:	
0-5,000 gallons	\$8.05 per 1,000 gallons
5,001-10,000 gallons	\$11.42 per 1,000 gallons
10,001-20,000 gallons	\$12.10 per 1,000 gallons
20,001-25,000 gallons	\$12.76 per 1,000 gallons
25,001-30,000 gallons	\$13.78 per 1,000 gallons
30,000+ gallons	\$14.88 per 1,000 gallons
State mandated regulatory assessment fee	$\frac{1}{2}$ % of total water usage.
Our new rates will be:	
0-5,000 gallons	\$8.53 per 1,000 gallons
5,001-10,000 gallons	\$12.11 per 1,000 gallons
10,001-20,000 gallons	\$12.83 per 1,000 gallons
20,001-25,000 gallons	\$13.53 per 1,000 gallons
25,001-30,000 gallons	\$14.61 per 1,000 gallons
30,000+ gallons	\$15.77 per 1,000 gallons
State mandated regulatory assessment fee	1/2% of total water usage.

The new rates will be effective beginning November 20, 2024, and will be reflected on your bill which is due January 10, 2025. Lakehaven residence rate increases will be reflected on your bill which is due January 1, 2025. Please be assured that the Board of Directors is committed to providing all customers of Copeville SUD with safe and dependable water at the most reasonable rates possible.
